

- reflexive possessive pronoun
 - possessor :: subject identity
- personal pronouns also possible
 - increasing tendency of use(?)
 - 1sg & 2sg >> 3sg / pl
 - viděla svoji kočku -- viděla její kočku 'she saw her cat' fandíme našim studujícím 'we support our students'



previous observations

 $nech_i m \check{e}_j sn \acute{i} st m \mathring{u} j / t v \mathring{u} j / s v \mathring{u} j_{i/j} dort 'let me eat my/your cake'$

- early discussions focused on contexts with nonfinite predications (e.g. daneš & hausenblas 1962)
- additional observations by čmejrková (2003)
 - interaction of syntax, semantics, & pragmatics
 - genre-specific usage (advertising)
 - svůj ~ distance between subject & possessum
 - alienability(?) "personal sphere of the possessor"
 - based on personal observations & informal corpus queries

perevozchikova 2023

- first systematic, corpus-based study
- 1sg possessor expression in bulgarian, czech, & russian
- sample of 1000 occurrences
 - aranea web corpora
 - up to two words between verb & possessive pronoun

present study

- extended follow-up on perevozchikova
 - similar patterns in our data?
 - other factors?
- 1sg & 2sg
- less restricted context
- intuitions of czech speakers

data

- corpus on-line1
 - social media posts, discussions, & forums
- distance from verb not restricted (sentence boundary tags)
- můj/svůj + finite verb 1sg & tvůj/svůj + finite verb 2sg




- a suite of syntactic & semantic variables
- Zvu Vás na mou besedu 'I invite you to my talk'

possessum animacy: inanimate	possessum semantics: alienable
position relative to the predicate: post	syntactic distance: not direct dependent
competitor for possessor identity: pro	presence of other possessive pronoun: no
agentivity of subject: actor	relative frequency with svůj: high

- estimated overall frequency of reflexive and personal usage
 - ~ 50% of data kept for personal pronouns
 - ~ 80% of data kept for svůj (1/2sg)



conditional inference trees & random forests + logistic regression



- Když jsem četla svoje starý tweety, tak jsem se pousmála nad tím, co mě trápilo 'When I was reading my old tweets I had to smile at what had been bothering me back then'
- ale kohoto tohle zajímá, když mu hned ve druhém řádku tvého komentáře nadáváš 'who gives a hoot when, right in the second line of your comment, you start calling him names'
- no effect of semantics
- room for improvement

personal pronouns in "reflexive contexts"

- contexts favoring svůj where a personal pronoun occurs
 - post-verbal, direct dependent, no competitor
- specific tokens/clusters of tokens
 - relatively high proportion of animate possessa with můj
 - 48.1% vs 24.8% in the rest of data
 - Klidně si tu piš ty tvé bludy...
 - 'Feel free to write these delusions of yours on here'
 - V-imprt that [expletive] something of yours!
 - expressive meaning, presence of demonstrative

what do czech speakers say?

- overlap between corpus patterns & speakers' intuitions?
- 20 sentences from the data
 - configuration of features favoring *svůj*/personal pronouns
- reflexive & personal version of each sentence presented
- two tasks
 - guess the original (N = 110)
 - "suitability/fittingness" rating (N = 139)
- each item followed by an unrelated "trivia" question
- participants aware of the phenomenon under investigation




- reflexive = default
- higher predicted probability of a personal pronoun → higher participant acceptability of the personal pronoun variant


guessing vs rating



ratings mis/align with original

- participants tended towards expected pronoun
 - Díky bohu, že v těch mejch super outfitech, v kterých venčím psa, nikoho nepotkávám.
 'Thank God, that in these wonderful outfits of mine that I wear when I walk my dog I don't meet anyone.'
- participants tended towards unexpected pronoun
 - Budu vědět, jak poroste hodnota bitcoinu, a s mými znalostmi do něj investuju nemalé peníze.
 'I'll know how Bitcoin's value will go up, and, with my knowledge, I'll invest a lot of money in it.'





conclusions

- no hints of svůj usage declining
- speakers' intuitions align with corpus data
- selection of pronoun predicted by structural factors
 - lexically (partially) specific clusters of tokens associated with particular variants
- more variables will be considered in further research
